**PACKET PICKUP:** Race day, Nov. 8, 7:30 - 9:15 am at the race site.

**COURSE:** The 5K Run/Walk (3.1miles) will take place on the SIUE Cross Country Course. The spectator friendly course is 98% grass, 2% gravel/asphalt. It is challenging with rolling terrain. Recent events hosted include NCAA Division II Regional & Conference Championships, Border Wars Championships, IHSA Regionals & Sectionals. [Course map Link:](#)

**LOCATION/DIRECTIONS:** The course resides on the campus of SIUE (Southern Illinois University Edwardsville) on the corner of New Poag Road & N University Drive. It is approximately a 20 minute drive from downtown St. Louis. [SIUE Campus Map Link.](#)

**From The West:** Take I-70 (East) to I-270 East (Indianapolis). Take the Illinois 157 North exit (exit #9). Turn left onto 157 North. Going straight at the stop light (instead of following 157 to the right) will bring you straight to the campus core. Continue going straight (North) thru campus and the cross country course will be on your left with parking on your right.

**From the South:** Take I-64 to I-255 North (Chicago). Take I-255 to I-270 East (Indianapolis). Take the Illinois 157 North exit (exit #9). Turn left onto 157 North. Going straight at the stop light (instead of following 157 to the right) will bring you straight to the campus core. Continue going straight (North) thru campus and the cross country course will be on your left with parking on your right.

**From the North/East:** Take I-55 to I-270 West (Kansas City). Exit I-270. Take the Illinois 157 North exit (exit #9). Turn right onto 157 North. Going straight at the stop light (instead of following 157 to the right) will bring you straight to the campus core. Continue going straight (North) thru campus and the cross country course will be on your left with parking on your right.

**PARKING:** Parking will be across the street from the starting field on a large grass lot. Overflow parking will be directed to SIUE campus lots. Parking on the street is prohibited & cars will be towed.
